



TRIPwire Account Invitation:

The Department of Homeland Security's Office for Bombing Prevention would like to invite you to apply for an account on TRIPwire. TRIPwire is a free online information-sharing network designed to increase awareness of evolving improvised explosive device (IED) tactics, techniques, and procedures.

TRIPwire collects, analyzes, and disseminates information on explosives-related incidents from around the world, provides incident lessons learned, and counter-IED preparedness information to enhance public and private sector capabilities. TRIPwire's vast collection of threat source material, official documents, videos, profiles, and incident data equips the nation's security professionals with the tools to prevent, protect against, respond to, and mitigate bombing incidents.

As an active member of the bombing prevention community, you are eligible for access to TRIPwire. To register for an account, please navigate your Internet Explorer browser to <http://www.tripwire.dhs.gov>. Click on the link, "Register for Account?" in the middle of the page. A new window will open with the registration form. Please fill in all information (fields marked with a "*" are required) and click "submit".

TRIPwire Eligibility:
